

## RESOLUTION 22-2025

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 30-11-101(1) (d), the Board has the authority to do all acts in relation to property necessary to exercise the corporate and administrative powers of the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 30-11-107 (e) the Board has the authority to manage the concerns of the county; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 30-11-101 (1) (i) the Board has the authority to dispose of county property by sale of said property if the Board determines it is in the best interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, based upon the aforementioned, the Board has learned that the Washington County Nursing Home has determined to dispose of three electric dryers Washington County Nursing Home Laundry Department as surplus, since the dryers have been replaced over the last two years with new commercial dryers.

Having reviewed this matter at a regularly scheduled Board meeting held on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 the Board of County Commissioners determined to take the following action:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY as follows:

1. The Board hereby recognizes the sale of three electric dryers as reported by the Washington County Nursing Home for the total amount received of \$225.00 to wit:

- a.) Serial # RS723701C Model GTX22EASK0NW
- b.) Serial # RS724304C Model GTX22EASK0WW
- c.) Serial # RS723703C Model GTX22EASK0WW

Dyers were sold to staff at a cost of \$75.00 each.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ward and on roll call vote, all votes being yes, the Resolution was adopted.
