## **RESOLUTION 54-2021**

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON WASHINGTON COUNTY'S PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS FOR WIND AND SOLAR POWER GENERATION FACILITIES AND ASSOCIATED POWER LINES IN ALL UNINCORPORATED PORTIONS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020 via Resolution 64-2020, the Board of County Commissioners imposed a temporary moratorium until September 24, 2020 on the acceptance, processing, or approval of applications for uses of land that involve the development of wind or solar power generation facilities and associated transmission lines;

WHEREAS, on November 24, 2020 via Resolution 89-2020, the Board of County Commissioners imposed an extension to the temporary moratorium until February 23, 2021 on the acceptance, processing, or approval of applications for uses of land that involve the development of wind or solar power generation facilities and associated transmission lines;

WHEREAS, County staff in conjunction with the County Planning Commission have been proceeding with due diligence to develop regulations that meet the needs of the County and finalized their recommended solar and wind power regulations on February 8, 2021, which was followed by a public hearing before the Planning Commission on February 8, 2021;

WHEREAS, the recommended regulations were subsequently delivered to the Board of County Commissioners for review on February 9, 2021 which will also require a properly noticed public hearing;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners anticipates that given the requirements of public hearings, and additional reviews required for the final regulations, they will not be effective sooner than April 13, 2021, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners therefore desires to extend the temporary moratorium to April 13, 2021.

## NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, COLORADO:

- 1. All the findings set forth in Resolution 64-2020 are hereby incorporated herein.
- 2. The moratorium set forth in Resolution 64-2020 is hereby extended to April 13, 2021 unless earlier terminated or further extended.
