

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 42-5-204 permits law enforcement agencies of local governments, which includes the Washington County Sheriff's Office, to collect a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per vehicle, adjusted annually for inflation, for the inspection of vehicle identification numbers ("VIN"s);

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 42-5-204(2)(b) requires that the proceeds from such fee be credited to a special fund in the office of the treasurer of the local government for use by the law enforcement agency for the administration and enforcement of vehicle identification number inspections, including the training and certification of inspectors; except that the governing body of the local government may order that the inspection fees be paid into the general fund of the local government; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("BOCC") desires to establish a VIN inspection fee as set forth herein and desires that the proceeds from such fee be used by the Washington County Sheriff's Office for the purposes set forth in C.R.S. § 42-5-204(2)(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that A VIN inspection fee in the amount established by the executive director of the Colorado Department of Revenue, currently of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), is hereby established for each VIN inspection performed by the Washington County Sheriff's Office.




