

**RESOLUTION 20-73**

**Resolution 20-73** It was moved by Commissioner Willeke and duly seconded by Commissioner Laybourn to approve a one-time variance to allow Morgan County REA (RW20-05) to utilize the county easement for a three phase overhead electrical utility installation. This will be located in W1/2W1/2 of sections 35 and 26, Township 3 South, Range 56 West. The respective landowners have requested that this be constructed on the west side of the current WAPA easement (the current utility corridor). This variance will allow for installation of the above ground overhead utility to occupy a portion of Washington County's unmaintained right of way. This variance does not assure Morgan County REA of the continued use of county rights of way in perpetuity.

The foregoing Resolution was presented at a regular meeting of the Washington County Commissioners held on the 2nd day of June 2020 by Commissioner Willeke who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Laybourn and on roll call vote, all votes being yes, the resolution was adopted.

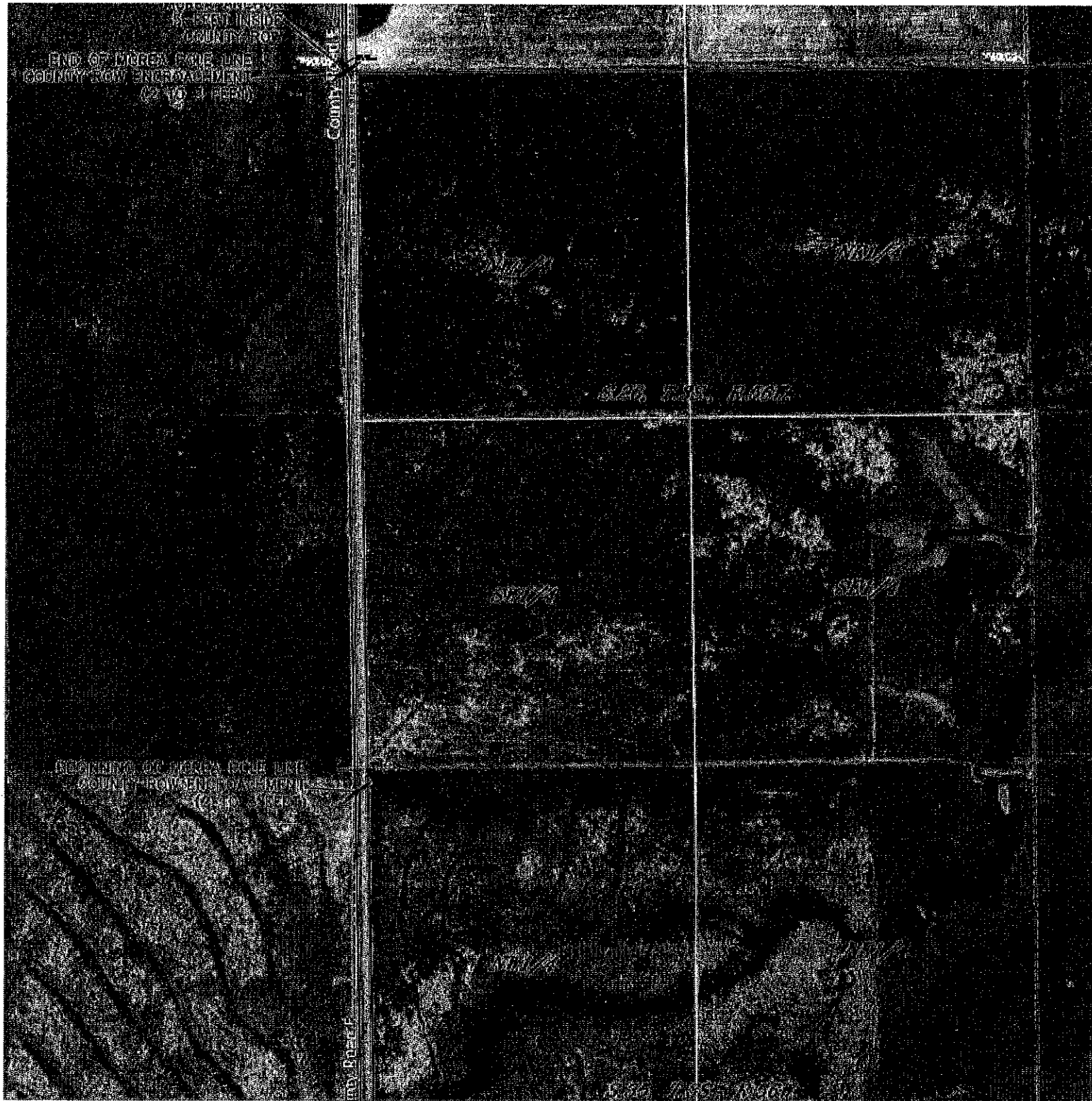
