

RESOLUTION 77-2022

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON WASHINGTON COUNTY'S PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS FOR TRANSMISSION LINES ASSOCIATED WITH WIND AND SOLAR POWER GENERATION FACILITIES IN ALL UNINCORPORATED PORTIONS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, having approved wind and solar regulations and having imposed a moratorium through August 30, 2022, on all transmission line applications to provide the County time to finalize its transmission regulations and related application forms, desires to extend the moratorium for thirty (30) additional days but only for transmission lines associated with wind and solar power generation facilities;

WHEREAS, this moratorium extension will provide additional time for the County to finalize its transmission line regulations and forms specific to wind and solar power generation facilities; and


WHEREAS, the moratorium on transmission lines other than those extending from wind and solar power generation facilities shall expire on June 30, 2022.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, COLORADO:


1. A moratorium on applications transmission line associated solely with wind and solar facilities is hereby imposed until September 30th, 2022.
2. The current moratorium on transmission lines other than those extending from wind and solar power generation facilities shall expire on June 30, 2022.
