RESOLUTION 87 - 2021

A RESOLUTION TO INSTITUTE A DRIVERS LICENSE FEE FOR NON-COUNTY COLORADO RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, Washington County voluntarily offers a driver's license service with county personnel and facilities; and

WHEREAS, residents outside Washington County routinely utilize the driver's license service provided by Washington County because State of Colorado driver's license offices in their own counties have limited hours, long wait times, or are closed to in-person services; and

WHEREAS, this influx of out-of-county Colorado residents causes additional workload for Washington County staff and

WHEREAS, the remuneration for providing these services on behalf of the State of Colorado is limited; and

WHEREAS, Washington County seeks to recover some of the uncompensated personnel and operating expenses for providing driver's licenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Washington County Clerk to charge a twenty dollar (\$20.00) fee for all out-of-county Colorado residents who obtain driver's licenses in Washington County.
 - 2. Revenue from this fee will be deposited in the Washington County General Fund.

The foregoing resolution was presented by Commissioner Vance for its adoption. Motion was seconded by Commissioner wells and upon call of the roll, all votes being aye, the Resolution was duly adopted.
