The Special meeting was called to order by Chairman Jefferson at 9:01 am.

It was moved by Commissioner Ramey and duly seconded by Commissioner Ward to approve the **consent agenda as presented**. On a roll call vote, all votes being yes, the motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Ramey and duly seconded by Commissioner Ward to **adopt Resolution 39-2025 extending the temporary moratorium on Washington County's process of applications for all solar power production facilities in all unincorporated portions of Washington County. The moratorium will be extended until September 17, 2025.** On a roll call vote, all votes being yes, the motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Ward and duly seconded by Commissioner Ramey to **adopt Resolution 40-2025, a resolution extending the temporary moratorium on the private transmission line in all unincorporated portions of Washington County pending consideration of amendments to the Washington County Zoning Regulations. That extends it until September 17th, 2025.** On a roll call vote, all votes being yes, the motion carried.
