The Case Aide for Child Welfare will provide supportive services to the Child Welfare cases under the direction and supervision of the Case Worker and/or Supervisor. The Office Aide responsibilities will be working with Eligibility in the program area under the supervision of the Eligibility Supervisor.

This position transports children and biological parents to necessary appointments and visits. In addition the Child Welfare Case Aide may be required to supervise visits as requested and perform additional needs as related to the Child Welfare Department. The Eligibility work may require data entry and scanning documents.
