

ELECTION INFORMATION

Ballots for the November 8, 2022, General Election will be mailed the week of October 17 – October 21, 2022. The General Election will be conducted as an **all-Mail Ballot Delivery Election**.

The ballot you receive in the mail is your official ballot. Ballots are mailed to all Active Eligible Voters. As soon as you receive your official ballot you may vote the ballot with your choices and then return it to the Clerk & Recorder's Office during office hours, by mail or in our 24/7 Drop Box.

Before sealing the envelope, please sign the signature affidavit located on the back of the envelope. This is required in order for your ballot to be processed. We must compare every signature to make sure that the intended voter was the one who signed the envelope.

Remember to allow enough time for the ballot to reach our office! Postmarks do not count! Mail-in ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. November 8, 2022.

Want to track your ballot? BallotTrax is a free service for Washington County Voters that allows you to track the status of your ballot online, as well as receive messages by text, phone, or email when your ballot has been sent to you and received by our Elections Division. Washington County voters may sign up at votewashingtounty.ballottrax.net

Already have BallotTrax: You might have received a message from BallotTrax on September 30 stating that your 2022 General Election ballot was mailed. That information was incorrect due to a data entry error on our part. Please be advised that your ballot has not yet been sent, but is scheduled to be mailed. We apologize for the error.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2022 GENERAL ELECTION:

- October 17 – 21, 2022: **Ballots will be mailed to all active eligible electors.**
- October 17, 2022, Monday: **Last day to submit an application to register to vote through a voter registration drive.** (no later than 22 days before the election)
- October 31, 2022, Monday: **Last day to submit an application to register to vote through the mail, a voter registration agency, a local driver's license examination facility, or online to receive a ballot in the mail for the General Election.** (Through the 8th day prior to the election)

- November 1, 2022, Tuesday: **Last day to file an absentee ballot application to receive the absentee ballot by mail.**
- October 31, 2022, Monday – November 8, 2022, Tuesday: **Voters can register to vote, obtain a replacement ballot or drop off their mail in ballots in person at the Washington County Clerk & Recorder’s Office Election Department 150 Ash Ave., Akron, CO 80720**
- **Washington County Clerk and Recorder’s Office Election Department** will be open on Saturday, November 5, 2022, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for ballot drop off, in person voting and replacement ballots.
- **November 8, 2022: ELECTION DAY** office hours 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
