

**NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION**  
**JUNE 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**TO THE ELECTORS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY:**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Tuesday the 28th day of June, 2022 a Primary Election will be held in Washington County as an all-mail ballot delivery election. Ballots were mailed to each active registered elector June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in accordance with C.R.S. Section 1-7.5-107(3)(a)(I).

**UNAFFILIATED VOTERS** your mail ballot packet contains both Democratic and Republican ballots, mark and return **ONLY ONE** of them and destroy the other. If you mark and return both ballots, neither will count.

**VOTERS MAY RETURN VOTED BALLOTS IN PERSON** at 150 Ash Ave, Akron, Colorado 80720 during regular business hours of Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; by mail (with proper postage affixed); or voters may use the secure drive-up ballot drop box located in the northeast corner of the courthouse at the alley between the courthouse and the Courthouse Annex.

**SELF AFFIRMATION:** The self-affirmation on the Mail Ballot Envelope **MUST BE SIGNED by the voter**. Please use **black or blue ink ONLY** to mark your ballot. Additionally, on the voter label if there is an "ID" Symbol or "ID Required", be sure to enclose a copy of your ID with your ballot. If your ID is required and not provided your voted ballot will NOT count.

**ALL VOTED** Official Ballots can be returned to the Washington County Clerk & Recorder P.O. Box L, 150 Ash Ave, Akron, Colorado 80720 via mail (with proper postage); or in person at the Clerk & Recorder's Office. Office hours are M-F 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and Election Day 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, the 28th day of June, 2022. **All voted ballots must be received by the Clerk and Recorder by 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 28th, 2022. POSTMARKS DO NOT COUNT!**

**24 HOUR DRIVE UP DROP BOX LOCATION:** Washington County Courthouse 150 Ash Ave, Akron, Colorado 80720, located in the northeast corner of the courthouse in the alley between the Courthouse and the Courthouse Annex.

Election Services provided at Washington County Clerk & Recorder's Office, Voter Service and Polling Center Location include registering to vote; updating voter information; replacement ballots; return of mail-in ballots; cast a ballot either by paper or electronic voting machine; cast a provisional ballot.

**UPDATES TO VOTER REGISTRATION:** To check or change your voter registration, visit [www.govotecolorado.gov](http://www.govotecolorado.gov) or contact the Washington County Clerk and Recorder's Office at 970-345-6565. Note that Colorado is a same-day-registration state, which means voters can register or update their voter registration all the way through Election Day at 7 p.m.

**TO MAIL A BALLOT TO THE VOTER:** the deadline for the Clerk and Recorder to receive a mail-in ballot application if voter is away from home is Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> of June, 2022. Last day for an individual to submit a voter registration application through the online voter registration system, the mail, voter registration agency, or local driver's license examination facility and receive a ballot via mail is Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> of June, 2022.

**REPLACEMENT BALLOTS:** If you spoil, deface, or lose your ballot, you may obtain a replacement ballot by contacting the Clerk and Recorder's Office at 150 Ash Ave, Akron, Colorado 80720, call 970-345-6565 or email [akuntz@co.washington.co.us](mailto:akuntz@co.washington.co.us)

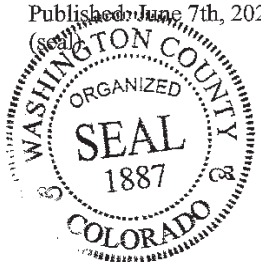
