DOLA Small Business Relief Grant

Washington County is participating in the State of Colorado's Small Business Relief Program (SBRP) that was created to allocate money to eligible small businesses operating within Washington County.

The SBRP defines an eligible small business as a corporation, LLC, partnership, sole proprietorship or other business entity that:

1. Has its headquarters located in and is doing business in Colorado
2. Has at least one full-time employee; unless a sole proprietorship
3. For businesses operating prior to January 1, 2020, annual receipts of less than \$2.5 million for 2019 calendar year
4. For businesses that began operations on or after January 1, 2020 and on or before March 26, 2020, annual receipts of less than \$2.5 million in the 2020 calendar year.
5. Is currently operating and has an intent to continue operating for at least 6 months
6. Has suffered at least 20% revenue loss since March 26, 2020, due to COVID restrictions imposed by the State of Colorado
7. Has a valid business license and is in good standing with the County.

Eligibility requirements:

- **Meets the small business criteria, as defined above, AND**
- **Is engaged in one of the following industry categories:**
 - Restaurant
 - Bar
 - Brewery
 - Winery
 - Distillery
 - Caterer
 - Movie theatre
 - Fitness center
